Faith

- 1** SUNDAY 'Faith is the reality of what we hope for, the proof of what we don't see.' (Hebrews 11:1)
- 2** MONDAY Jesus told him, "Because you have seen Me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed". (John 20:29)
- 3** TUESDAY 'Faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.' (Romans 10:17)
- 4** WEDNESDAY 'And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him.' (Hebrews 11:6)
- 5** THURSDAY 'God's righteousness is being revealed in the gospel, as it is written, "The righteous person will live by faith".' (Romans 1:17)
- 6** FRIDAY 'For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.' (John 3:16)
- 7** SATURDAY/ SABBATH 'Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, "Move from here to there," and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you.' (Matthew 17:20)

- 1** SUNDAY 'Why, I ask myself, are you so depressed? Why are you so upset inside? Hope in God!' (Psalm 42:11)
- 2** MONDAY 'For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.' (Jeremiah 29:11)
- 3** TUESDAY 'Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.' (Isaiah 40:31)
- 4** WEDNESDAY 'And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love had been poured into our hearts.' (Romans 5:5)



- 5** THURSDAY 'Let's hold on to the confession of our hope without wavering, because the one who made the promises is reliable.' (Hebrews 10:23)
- 6** FRIDAY 'Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer.' (Romans 12:12)
- 7** SATURDAY/ SABBATH 'May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in faith so that you overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.' (Romans 15:13)

- 1** SUNDAY 'Do everything in love.' (1 Corinthians 16:14)
- 2** MONDAY "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: "Love your neighbour as yourself". (Matthew 22:37-39)
- 3** TUESDAY 'Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves has been born of God, and knows God. He who doesn't love doesn't know God, for God is love.' (1 John 4:7, 8)
- 4** WEDNESDAY 'Love is patient, love is kind. Love does not envy, is not boastful, is not arrogant . . .' (1 Corinthians 13:4)

- 5** THURSDAY 'There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear.' (1 John 4:18)
- 6** FRIDAY 'This is how we know what love is: Christ gave His life for us.' (1 John 3:16)
- 7** SATURDAY/ SABBATH 'Now these three remain: faith, hope, and love – but the greatest of these is love.' (1 Corinthians 13:13)
